## HUNT EASTERN CAUCASUS (DAGESTAN) TUR IN AZERBAIJAN

(Capri cylindricornis)

Tur live at altitudes between 7,000' and 10,000'. They are considered by many to be the cross between the wild sheep and mountain goats. This is one of the most prized species in mountain hunting. This is a CITES II animal. Dagestan Tur hunting is considered to be one of the most difficult mountain hunts. East-Caucasian Tur is included both in Capra and OVIS Slams that's why it is very important as a mountain trophy. In Ismayily area (7 hours driving from Baku city – capital of Azerbaijan) there are two exclusive hunting zones River Keshene and KEL DAG, located in 3 hours driving from each other. This outfitter can accept groups from 1 to 7 hunters at the same time but each hunter will be accompanied by 2-3 hunting guides and will be hunting separately from the other clients in fly camp. Normally hunting lasts 5 days. The first and the last days you usually spent at the base camp in a big house with hot and cold running water. You will rest there while the guides take care of your trophy and prepare for further transportation.

**Prices Exclude:** International flight to Baku Heydar Aliyev Airport (GYD), On line Visa: \$20, hotel and meals before/after the hunt, gratuities (recommended \$250 for guide and \$80 for cook per hunter), insurance, personal expenses, trophy shipment, gratuities, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document. Firearm rental \$300 plus bullets (Russian Rifle-Tigr with optics). Helicopter from Baku to mountains and back an option at the expense of client.

**Reservations & Payments per person in U.S. Dollars only:** Confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit to hold the hunt dates. The balance is to be paid 30 days before the hunt. **Travel:** Fly to Baku through Istanbul. Spend the night in Baku. Travel to hunting area via car, truck, and return. Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#). All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.

**Itinerary:** Day 1 – Arrive Baku via Istanbul-overnight-not included  
 Day 2 – Transfer to Base Camp – 6-8 hours  
 Day 3 thru 7 - Hunt Days  
 Day 8 – Return to Baku-overnight-not included  
 Day 9 – Depart for home
