BROWN BEAR HUNT ON THE OAT FIELDS

This is traditional old-style bear hunt in North-East areas of European Russia. Bears become here size of average 7 foot, with some exceptional 8 foot trophies taken every year. Hunt is done mostly at the night-time on high seats on oat fields. This is why the hunter has to look to the full moon phase to come on this hunt. You will enjoy the Russian hospitality in the heart of old Russia!

GROUP SIZE: 1 - 3 hunters

ACCOMMODATION: hunting lodge based on double occupancy, sauna.

ITINERARY

Day 1 arrival in Moscow, transfer to Kirov by night-sleeper train, 12 hours

Day 2 arrival in Kirov in the morning, transfer to the hunting area between 1-3 hrs depending on which area you hunt.
 Hunt in the evening.

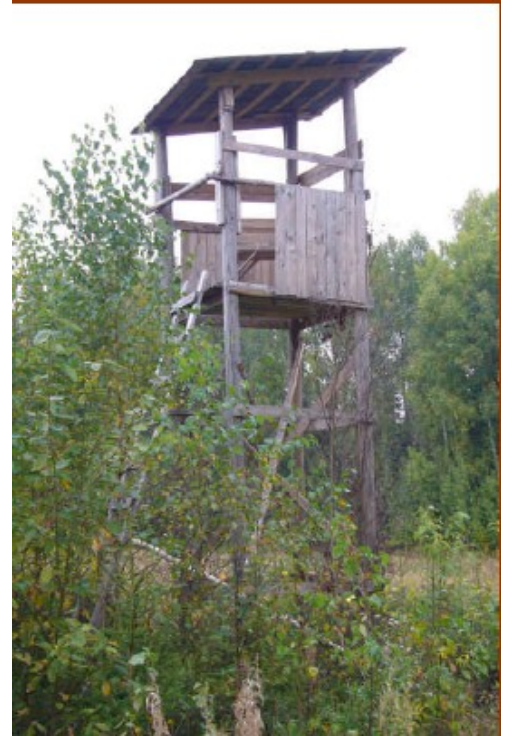
Day 3-9 7 day hunt

Day 10 transfer by train to Moscow

Day 11 arrival in Moscow in the morning, departure Moscow

PRICE INCLUDES: meeting and drop off at the airport; all transportation to and from the hunting region; all transportation (UAZ-jeeps) in the hunting area; accommodation and food in the camp during the whole tour; service of professional guide; all serving staff including one interpreter per group/camp; trophy care and packing for shipment.

PRICE EXCLUDE: airline ticket to/from Moscow; train to/from Kirov; items of a personal nature; hotel and meals in Moscow; excess luggage payment charged by airlines; sightseeing program; a \$400 formalities package which includes invitation letter, firearm permit, hunting permit, state fee, veterinary certificate, meeting and transportation upon arrival in Moscow, service of an interpreter in Moscow; \$300 for CITES Export Permit, train ticket from Moscow to Kirov and return which is approximately \$300 2nd class and \$500 1st class (price for train ticket is subject to change); special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.



RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT: per person in U.S. Dollars only A 50 % deposit is required to hold your hunt date. FINAL PAYMENT is due 60 days prior to hunt starting date. Cancellation 90 days prior to hunt starting date, the full deposit is refunded less \$1,500 per hunting client handling fee. Cancellation 90 to 61 days prior to hunt starting date, the full deposit is forfeited. Cancellation 60 days or less prior to hunt starting date, the total hunt cost is forfeited.

Note: you must bring your own sleeping bag, field thermos, sunglasses and one pair of long (up to the hip) waterproof boots.
