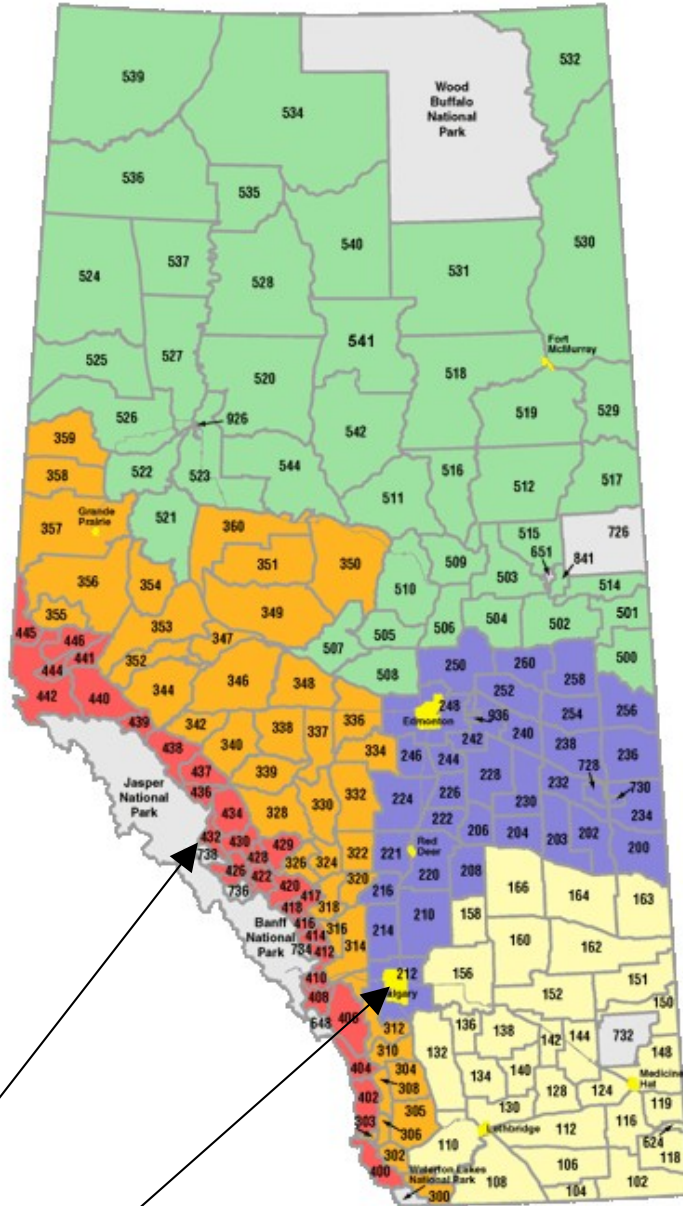

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS: Per person in U.S. Dollars only, confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit with balance in cash due upon arrival in camp. Canada-if you take more than CAN\$10,000 into or out of Canada, you must fill out a [Customs Form E667](#). You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). Balance is due in cash at the beginning of the hunt. Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#) (in triplicate). Your “proof of legal take” is your hunting license and tag. Harvested sheep must be registered at the Canadian Fish and Wildlife office. You can then take your trophy home. This process takes only 1 hour but needs to be registered Monday-Friday. All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.
