TEXAS

BARBARY (AODAD) BIGHORN SHEEP (*Ammotragus lervia*)

Aoudad (Barbary sheep) hunts take place in the mountains of West Texas. We consider the Barbary Bighorn to be a native species as they have been roaming the Southwest mountains for over 60 years. This area has some of the largest parcels of uninhabited land left in the lower 48 states. The total amount of private land that is hunted is about 283,000 acres on 6 different private ranches. All of these ranches are a sheep hunter's delight. They are rough and rocky and have the typical desert habitat. These ranches have low rolling hills to steep mountainous terrain. It will help to be in shape, because half of this hunt will be on foot in the mountains. The elevations range from 4500-7000 feet. These are great ranches for the serious sheep hunter to collect a trophy ram.



Taking quality rams is no accident. You have to be hunting where the gene pool is excellent and on large properties that have had little hunting pressure. One to three rams per year are taken from each ranch. In the last 2 seasons our hunters have taken 8 rams that score from 148 SCI - 156 6/8 SCI in the free range category--**TOP 20 of All-Time!!! We currently have the #3 and the #4 Aoudad in the latest SCI record book.** Our goal is to harvest the World Record Free Range Fair Chase Aoudad Ram. It is not uncommon to see **100-150** total and **4-6** trophy rams. It is also very important to note that these sheep have been wild and free ranging since the mid-1940s.

Last season we took 2 rams over 33", 4 over 32", 6 more over 30", and the rest were over 28" (19 rams total). All of these rams were over 10 years of age.



These hunts are **4 days** in length and are fully guided with two hunters to one guide. You can fly into [El Paso, Texas](#) or [Midland/Odessa, Texas](#) the day before your hunt and rent a car and drive to Marfa, Alpine, or Shafter, Texas (3 hour drive) where you will be met. Plan on being at one of these three locations no later than 5pm central time. Temperatures will range from 20°F - 85°F.

Carmen Mountain Whitetail (close relative to Coues deer) can be combined on November and December Hunt for an additional trophy fee.



Javelina may also be taken on this hunt if time permits, at an additional charge.

This is the best value for a free-range trophy sheep hunt in North America.

At the 2008 SCI convention, one of our hunters, Dave Connor, received the number 1 award for the largest free range aoudad taken the last two years.

The gear that you need to bring is your rifle, binoculars, day bag or light backpack, and personal gear. You will stay in ranch houses, motels, or tents depending on the site we are hunting. A good light rifle in calibers from **270-300 mag** will do fine (custom rifles(7mm mag.) will be provided at no additional charge if the hunter does not wish to travel with his rifle), a well broken in pair of leather boots with a good vibram sole is a must.

NALGAI

(Boselaphus tragocamelus)

HUNT free ranging NILGAI in low fence country that has not been commercially hunted. One on one guided hunts on a coastal plains ranch in South Texas. Nilgai are the hardest to hunt and the toughest to kill of any animal on the North American continent. Hunting Nilgai is addicting if you appreciate "the Hunt".

1 Day 0 nights 1 Bull	\$1,800.00

A wounded animal belongs to the hunter. If for some reason the shot taken is missed, the hunt continues for the duration of the hunting period booked. Lomas Chicas Outfitters will exhaust all measures known and available to us to retrieve your animal. For an additional cost of \$500.00 and subject to availability, the hunter may choose to hunt the following day beyond the period booked. In the instance a hunter books for just one animal and then decides to take another animal, the 2nd animal prices below:

2 nd animal any hunt Nilgai Bull	\$1,200.00
2 nd animal any hunt Nilgai Cow	\$ 800.00
Wild Hogs each	\$ 100.00
Extra Night lodging	\$ 60.00
Non-hunter Per Day	\$ 125.00

Hunts start the afternoon before giving the hunter(s) a 72 hour window encompassing four days, which will be more than adequate to get their trophy.

Many who have hunted in Africa compare Nilgai to Cape buffalo in difficulty to kill. The meat is high on the list of desirable game meat. Many people with cholesterol problems choose to include Nilgai meat in their diet because it has a very low cholesterol count.



Our goal is to make your hunt a most rewarding, comfortable and pleasurable experience. Accommodations are not on site but, are very nearby and extremely comfortable with meals that are second to none.

This is a spot and stalk hunt! There is no sitting around in a blind waiting for these animals to come to you. This is a challenging yet very rewarding hunt. Once you have been on a Nilgai hunt, all else fails to compare.

We require that you bring a Caliber of 300 mag. or better and note that a back up shot will be provided (if absolutely needed). Practice your shooting, practice your breathing and you will do fine. You will find that practice will pay off. Choose a bullet that will provide the largest wound channel possible. Check with your gun or bullet dealer and let them help you.

PRICE INCLUDES: A guarantee shot at a mature Nilgai of your gender choice, accommodations, food and beverages, trophy field preparation. If arriving in Texas by plane to Corpus Christi, Harlingen, Falfurrias, or Kingsville, you will pick you up and shuttle you back in time for your return flight. We would suggest and prefer Corpus Christi for commercial flyers. This will allow more time for your hunt.

PRICE EXCLUDES: Trophy shipment, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

I saw more mature bulls on the first afternoon hunting than I had seen total Nilgai (bulls, cows, calves) in all my previous hunts combined. I was able to anchor a very fine bull the first afternoon. The hunting method, abundance of game, scenery and excellent guiding became addictive. On the second day I couldn't stand it anymore and purchased a "second animal" hunt ... a Nilgai cow. The hunt was on again, and after an even more challenging stalk than the first day, I was able to drop a cow.
