This outfitter tracks on dry land as well as in the snow. His goal is to harvest a 140# or greater Mountain Lion. High Mountain Hunts will hold your money until the outfitter has a treed mountain lion of approximately 140# or greater. At that point, you can either take the treed lion or pass and continue hunting for a larger lion for the remaining days booked and your guarantee has been met. If you take the lion, he's yours even if he doesn't meet the 140# goal and the guarantee has been met. If you can't physically make it to the treed lion, your guarantee has been met.

**Booking for 2017**

**Included:** Pick-up and return to airport in St. George, Utah, skinning and prepping of animal, meals and lodging in outfitter's home, use of 4x4 trucks, ATV, snowmobile, outfitter will have up to 3 trucks dragging roads and looking for fresh tracks, use of Outfitter's firearm.

**Not Included:** 6% Sales Tax must be paid in advance and will be added into the Contract as part of the Cost of the Hunt, Cost of license (you must purchase license 3 days prior to the beginning of hunt), airfare to St. George, Utah (or outfitter will pick you up/take you back to Las Vegas,

Nevada (a 2 hour drive for a fee of \$100). This fee will be added into your Contract) gratuities, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalization and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document. If you were born after December 31, 1965, you must provide proof that you've passed a hunter education course approved by the Utah Division of Wildlife before you can apply for or obtain a hunting license or a cougar permit. <http://wildlife.utah.gov/hunter-education.html>. **Reservations & Payments per person in U.S. Dollars only:** Confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit to hold the hunt dates. The balance is to be paid 30 days before the hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#).



Are you considering a cougar hunt in Utah this year? If so, you'll need to make sure you meet Utah's age, hunter education and license requirements before you apply for the Harvest Objective Permit. If you were born after December 31, 1965, you must provide proof that you've passed the hunter education course approved by the Utah Division of Game and Fish before you can apply for or obtain a hunter license or a cougar permit. You can prove that you have completed the course by obtaining a Certificate of Completion (this certificate is called a "blue card" in Utah) or by using a hunting license from a previous year with your hunter education number noted on the license.

Have you passed hunter education? If you have qualified in your state, it will qualify in Utah. You must show proof. Go to <http://wildlife.utah.gov/hunter-education.html> to obtain your Certificate or to transfer your Certification, click on the "Common Questions" then click on "How to Transfer", then click on "This Form".
